West Side Paso Robles

60% Debro Vineyard Syrah
40% Halter Ranch Hillside Syrah

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Blended from two clones of Syrah, Clone 99 and Estrella, grown on the cooler, West side of Paso Robles. Aromas of black cherries, licorice, plums, roasted meat, chocolate, and toasty oak lead in to flavors of blackberries and pie cherries. Firm tannins in the mid palate turn to a nice finish with bright acidity.

VINEYARD SOURCES:

West Side Paso Robles

100% McGourty Vineyard Sangiovese

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Another wine sourced from the West side of Paso Robles. Sangiovese focuses on aromas of blackberries, pepper, and plum which frame the bouquet of this wine. Currant, blackberry, and coffee flavors integrated with toasty oak trail off into a long layered finish.

VINEYARD SOURCES:

West Side Paso Robles

65% McGourty Vineyard Sangiovese
35% Rochelle Cabernet Sauvignon

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Also from vineyards in the cooler West side, this wine is modeled after the Italian Super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. White pepper, dried cherries, ripe plums, cedar, sage, and vanilla aromas give way to a soft entry of pie cherries and boysenberries. This wine finishes with firm tannins and a round mouth feel.
